AN ACT

Relating to Blount County; authorizing the county commission to call an advisory referendum concerning emergency telephone service.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of Alabama:

Section 1. In Blount County, the county commission is hereby authorized to call an advisory referendum as to whether or not the qualified electors want to adopt the emergency telephone service, E-911, pursuant to Section 11-98-1 et seq., Code of Alabama 1975. Said referendum shall be held at the next general, special, constitutional or county election in Blount County.

Section 2. This act shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval by the Governor, or upon its otherwise becoming a law.

AN ACT

Relating to Madison County; providing further for the salary of the county tax collector and county tax assessor.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of Alabama:

Section 1. Beginning with the next term of office of tax collector and tax assessor on October 1, 1991, the annual salary shall be \$46,000.00. Such salary shall be in lieu of any other annual salaries and expense allowances heretofore provided by law for such officers to be paid in equal monthly installments from the county general fund on warrants processed in the usual manner.

Section 2. All laws or parts of laws which conflict with this act are hereby repealed.

Section 3. This act shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval by the Governor, or upon its otherwise becoming a law.
